GENERAL INFORMATION

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Aerus Elevate pH600+ Reverse Osmosis Drinking Water System incorporates 6 total stages of treatment.

First, the water passes through sediment pre-filtration, then two stages of activated carbon. Then, the NSF approved reverse osmosis membrane removes impurities in the form of organics and/or dissolved solids. The final two polishing stages are of activated carbon, removing all traces of any lingering tastes or odors. An optional alkaline stage is available, and can be substituted for one of the carbon post filters. This pH enhancing step will raise the alkalinity to a much higher level, providing re-mineralization for enhanced hydration.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS




- This system is intended for use on potable water supplies or disinfected water containing cysts. Do not use where water is microbiologically unsafe or with water of unknown quality. If bacterial contamination is present, a recognized method of water disinfection is required.
- The Aerus® Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System contains a replaceable reverse osmosis membrane filter which is critical for the effective reduction of Total Dissolved Solids. The filtered water should be tested periodically to verify that the system is performing properly.

Read this manual in its entirety before using your Aerus Elevate pH600+


- DO NOT use System on untreated well water that is microbiologically unsafe
- DO NOT exceed 100 psi (0.69 Mpa) water pressure
- DO NOT exceed 86°F (30°C) water temperature
- DO NOT subject System to freezing conditions
- All plumbing must be in compliance with local and state plumbing codes
- Inspect all plumbing connections; check for leaks and make repairs as needed




SIX FILTER CARTRIDGES





WATER TANK





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



- If countertop is granite, it is strongly recommended that drilling is performed by a professional
- Check local codes on proper drain connection
- · When cutting the tubing, make it clean, square cuts; failing to do so result in poor connection and possible leaks
- The lowest point of the line should be the point of connection to the Drain Clamp
- There should be no sag in the line as this may cause excessive noise as the reject water is flowing to drain

STEP1-FEED VALVE INSTALLATION


- Turn off cold water supply either at the main or angle stop
- Install feed valve (per diagram) between angle stop and faucet hose
- Connect 3/8" tubing from RO Feed Port
- · Valve Feed Valve closed and turn water supply back on

STEP 2 - FAUCET INSTALLATION

- · Select a convenient location near the sink to place faucet
- Drill a hole in the selected location (hole size can vary depending on the faucet brand, and whether or not it is equipped with an air gap)
- · Place faucet, and install gaskets, plates, washers, and nut as illustrated (air gap faucet hardware can vary)
- Connect 3/8" tubing from RO Faucet/Product Port to center threaded stem, and if air gap equipped, connect 1/4" and 3/8" drain lines as illustrated

Gap Faucet Diagram




Typical connection configuration can vary.

NOTE:

To hose feeding Feed Valve raw water faucet: From cold water 3/8" tubing to supply/angle stop RO Feed Port

Typical Air Gap Faucet Diagram




STEP 3 - DRAIN SADDLE INSTALLATION

- · Locate drain saddle on drain pipe above the "P" trap and tighten securely
- Remove the collet and o-ring from the drain saddle fitting, and use the hole as a guide to locate and drill a 1/4" hole in the drain pipe (DO NOT drill through both sides)
- Replace the o-ring and collet, and insert the 3/8" tubing from the air gap device (if necessary to reduce to 1/4" drain tubing, a stem reducer fitting is supplied)

IMPORTANT:

- Check all local plumbing codes to ensure proper drain connection
- If connecting drain line to a dishwasher drain adaptor, elevate the drain line to ensure that drain flow from the RO does not backflow into the dishwasher



NOTE: Drain saddle Illustration is typical, connection configuration can vary.

PRECAUTIONS BEFORE USE



- Replace filters regularly
- Do not disassemble parts randomly, it may cause leakage or damage
- Do not store in an environment of 32 °F (0 °C) or below

SYSTEM PLACEMENT

The RO System can be operated in a horizontal (laying down) position. However, before being placed into service in that position (upon start-up or after Filter replacement), all air must be purged while in a vertical position.

REMINDERS

- Turn off source water immediately if troubles occur and call an Authorized Aerus Representative or Customer Service
- Before turning on the source water, make sure the Aerus Elevate pH 600* Water Purification System is fully installed and operating correctly
- Run water through the Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System for 10 to 15 minutes before drinking the water
- · Let the Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System operate normally for over 90 minutes before testing the water

First	Sediment P/N: 50079	Polypropylene filter for removal of sand, silt, dirt and rust particles.	6 months
Second	Carbon Block P/N: 50080	Removes suspended particles, organics, and chlorine	6 months
Third	Activated Carbon P/N: 50081	Reduces remaining chlorine by-products	6 months
Fourth	Reverse Osmosis Membrane P/N: 50082	Reduces up to 99% of total dissolved solids and organics	24 months
Fifth	Activated Carbon (standard) P/N: 50081	Polishes product water leaving gas permeable RO membrane	6 months
	Alkaline (optional) P/N: 50083	Greatly elevates pH of product water, enhancing hydration	6 months
Sixth	Polishing Carbon P/N: 50081	Coconut carbon removes any taste or odor from storage tank	6 months




Shut off the source water before replacing the filters.


FILTER REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS


REMINDER: When replacing filters, match the color on the filter label with the color label placed below the filter.

1. Remove the side panel.




2. Lift up the filter 30 $^{\circ}$, rotate counterclockwise, then pull down and remove the filter.






3. Install new filter by pushing up into header bar and rotating clockwise according to specifications. Re-attach the side board panel.









WATER TREATMENT PROCESS DIAGRAM

Limited Three (3) Year Warranty

WHAT IS COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY

We warrant the Aerus Elevate pH600+ Water Purification System to the consumer, subject to the conditions below, against defects in workmanship or material, provided that the products are returned to an Aerus location within the following time periods:

 The Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System (excluding replaceable filters and RO membrane) within 3 years of date of purchase

INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS

This warranty is expressly conditioned upon the following installation and maintenance requirements: (i) the Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System must be installed by a licensed professional; (ii) the Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System must be installed in accordance with National, State & local plumbing codes and the Owner's Manual; (iii) all filters and RO membrane must be replaced at the intervals prescribed in the Owner's Manual (proof of filter change may be required) and (iv) the Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System must be used and maintained in accordance with the Owner's Manual. Failure to meet any of these requirements will void this warranty. Servicing your Aerus Elevate pH 600+ Water Purification System by parties other than an Authorized Aerus Representative and/or using parts other than genuine Aerus parts will also void this warranty.

HOW TO OBTAIN WARRANTY SERVICE

Customer must contact Aerus Customer Service or go online to www.aerusonline.com/site/warrantyform to activate their warranty within 1-year of purchase. We will repair or replace and return the product, without charge and within a reasonable period of time, subject to the conditions in the above paragraphs, if its examination shall disclose any part to be defective in workmanship or material. If we, in our discretion, are unable to repair the product after a reasonable number of attempts, we will provide either a refund of the purchase price or a replacement unit, at the company's option.
